- Club officials and participants will follow **Virginia** state and local guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time.

- There will be two ring gates, one for dogs entering and one for exiting.

Exhibitor Practices

- Plan to be self-sufficient: bring a generator for electricity, Bring plenty of snacks, ice and drinking water.
- Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring.
- While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.
- Grooming beside the exhibitor's vehicle including the use of pop-up tents is recommended, No grooming tent will be provided

Judge Practices

- All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges should practice ring awareness and be conscious of spacing
- Judges may have the exhibitor display the oral exam.
- Judges may sanitize hands after examining each entry.
- Judges may personally pull ribbons or allow the option of having the exhibitor pick up their ribbon from the exit table as they leave the ring

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. DIRECTIONS

From the NORTH - VIA I-64 East or West

Exit off I-64 at exit 152. Turn SOUTH toward the Goochland Drive-In, Pass the Drive-In and then turn RIGHT onto US-250 W. Immediately turn LEFT onto State Rte 629. After .2 mile, Rt. 629 becomes Rte. 606. Follow for 7.7 miles and turn LEFT to stay on Rt. 606. After 1.1 miles, turn SHARP RIGHT onto Rt 6 West (River Road West), then make the next LEFT onto Rt. 45 South (Cartersville Rd). Follow for 6.4 miles, and go slight LEFT onto Deep Run Rd (Rt. 616). After 2.3 miles, continue onto Jennings Rd (Rt. 607), and then after another .7 miles, turn right into the Hunting Preserve. Watch for Dog Show Signs.

From the SOUTH - VIA Route 60 East or West

From US Rt 60 (near Cumberland) turn onto VA-45 North and go for 9.4 miles. Turn RIGHT onto Jennings Rd. After .5 miles, Turn left into the Hunting Preserve. Watch for the dog show signs.
